CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz 2014

Resume: overflowing cinemas and international festival flair

Today the **eleventh** CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz comes to an **extremely successful conclusion**. For six days enthusiasm for European filmmaking turned Linz into the center of the international festival map. Once again, this enthusiasm mobilized over **20,000 visitors** (estimating the last day of the festival with 28 film programs and the networking event "Picture your SOUND your Picture"), who imbued the capital of Upper Austria with an inimitable festival flair.

Daring to **orientate the contents of an entire festival to Europe**, but without losing sight of marginal zones, socio-political imbalances or social wounds, has again proved its worth – much to the delight of the Festival Director Christine Dollhofer and her team on the last day of the festival today.

This year the festival began with an impressive festival opening on Friday, 25 April – the opening event, the film screenings and the Nightline were already stormed by the audience. This trend happily continued, which is due, not least of all, to the presence of numerous renowned international film guests (including the outstanding directors Joanna Hogg and Claire Simon and the Italian old master of horror Dario Argento), who further enhanced the attractiveness of the festival. A total of **184** feature films, documentaries, and short films from **37** different countries (including 98 Austrian premieres and 28 world premieres) flickered across the screens, and roughly 700 industry guests from Austria and abroad – including over 150 film guests – were counted.

Festival Director Christine Dollhofer looks back on an inspiring week: over 20,000 **festival guests and film and music lovers** attended the film screenings, exhibitions, talks, lectures and the Nightline of the festival. Although the number of events in the framework program was somewhat reduced this year, due to a significant increase in the number of visitors in the cinemas at the screenings, last year's record of 20,000 visitors was just surpassed – this is a clear affirmation of the programmatic orientation of the festival.

From the beginning, CROSSING EUROPE has been devoted to the idea of arousing enthusiasm for sophisticated European filmmaking – the **uncompromising program selection**, international and local networking, and a direct engagement with the (international) filmmakers have thus again proved their worth. Keyword engagement: never before have so many festival guests attended the discussion and talk events, actively taking part in the film discourse. In addition, horror film fans were especially thrilled – Giallo director Dario Argento from Italy enhanced the festival with his charming presence.

The Local Artists jury [Brigitta Burger-Utzer (AT), Sebastian Höglinger (AT), Sabine Retschitzegger (AT)] stated: "The Local Artist Award 2014 goes to a film that stands out in its formal consistency; a film that demands relentless concentration from the audience. Memories of a day in the Bosnian war are meanderingly woven into a verbal image. The text level is actually inscribed in the film picture, sometimes overwrites it, and its physical presence rejects any aestheticization of what is remembered. In keeping with this, the sound remains silent. Specifically this dedramatization of the events, however, allows an inkling of the trauma that is never named as such."
