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RESUME - CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz 2015

Outstanding program, international festival flair, and record number of visitors

Today the twelfth CROSSING EUROPE Film Festival Linz comes to a highly successful conclusion. Festival Director Christine Dollhofer is pleased to announce a new audience record this year. Almost 22.000 festival visitors (estimating the last festival day with 28 film programs) **stormed** the venues and transformed the Upper Austrian Culture Quarter into the vibrant hub of the provincial capital city.

From the beginning, CROSSING EUROPE has been dedicated to the idea of accessibly presenting **sophisticated European filmmaking** here in Linz, and to offer international and local networking along with the possibility of direct exchange with the filmmakers present from all over Europe. In 2015 the festival audience again took over the festival locations for six days – turning the OK Platz into the vibrant hot spot of the city at the same time.

A total of **160** selected feature films, documentaries and short films from **45** different countries (109 of them premieres) were presented in the mostly sold-out cinemas, around 700 professionals from Austria and abroad – including roughly 160 film guests – were counted. Almost **22.000 festival guests and film and music enthusiasts** attended the film screenings, exhibitions, talks and the nightline of the festival. This means that CROSSING EUROPE this year has broken last year's record (20.000).

The rise in the number of visitors was already evident on the first day of the festival, and there was no break in the enthusiasm of the festival audience in Linz for contemporary auteur cinema from Europe. The festival opening on 23 April was already wholly in line with the programmatic orientation of the festival – to arouse enthusiasm for artistic auteur cinema from Europe among the audience, to take the visitors along on a – sometimes uncomfortable – journey right through Europe of today, while focusing attention at the same time on social-political inequalities and the social wounds of our continent. There was room in the program for burning topics such as "Fortress Europe", migration and economic crisis, as well as works on music & youth culture and the program focal point CINEMA NEXT EUROPE focusing on the "next generation" of European filmmakers. The cinephile highlight was undoubtedly this year's Tribute, which was devoted to the acclaimed and award-winning director Sergei Loznitsa, who presented a total of 18 films – largely Austrian premieres – in person during CROSSING EUROPE and held a masterclass for a full house. The presence of many international film guests was altogether conspicuous this year, and like the local filmmakers they engaged with the audience in film discussions.

Perspectives

For the future as well, Christine Dollhofer and her team intend to bring together the demands of a professional audience and a local cinema audience, and with CROSSING EUROPE to enable a vibrant event for the presentation

and discussion of contemporary, sometimes uncomfortable or artistically eccentric, social-critical auteur cinema from Europe. The first principle is – and will be in the future – to spotlight the diverse nuances of the (film) continent of Europe. This covers a broad thematic range (political upheavals, economic crises or the conscious withdrawal from society) and is marked by very different artistic approaches and signatures. CROSSING EUROPE continues to see itself as an outstanding film event with a highly diverse film program and as an invitation to engage directly with European life worlds.

After this year's highly positive and successful festival, the festival director is confident that the patrons, sponsors and funding partners (around 70 this year) will continue to financially and ideally support CROSSING EUROPE adequately to the same extent as before.
